



## Registration start for ŠKODA Velotour 2023 - 1,500 early bird places available

Just in time for today's World Bike Day, there is a special gift for classic bike fans. Registration for the next ŠKODA Velotour is now open. On May 1, 2023, the race will once again take amateur cyclists through the Taunus region. Those who already book their starting place for the coming spring at <a href="https://www.skoda-velotour.de">www.skoda-velotour.de</a> will save a lot of money.

For the first 1,500 starters, a particularly inexpensive "Early Bird" contingent is available. For example, the start of the ŠKODA Velotour Skyline - the short distance over 40 flat kilometers between Eschborn and Frankfurt - costs only 35 euros.

Quick decisions are in demand. Last year, it took less than 48 hours for the "Early Bird" places to be allocated. If the attractive early bird contingent is fully booked, the entry fee increases by 15 euros.

On May 1, 6,200 riders\* experienced the three routes of the ŠKODA Velotour. Next year, in addition to the short, flat distance, which appeals primarily to cycling beginners, the two Taunus courses are again on the program. The ŠKODA Velotour Taunus Classic is the highlight for ambitious road cyclists. On 100 kilometers, all Taunus icons, from the Feldberg to the Mammolshainer Stich, have to be completed. 1,700 meters of altitude difference make the course a true amateur cyclist classic. For whom the Mammolshainer challenge is too much, can choose the ŠKODA Velotour Taunus Express (88 kilometers) and skip this climb.
